assessing dues

Member agencies assess their own dues annually based upon all of the member agency's expenditures in program areas impacted by Alliance advocacy activities including: adoption, education, family-based services, foster family agencies, juvenile justice, mental health, and residential care. A member agency's programs and service areas that are clearly and unequivocally outside the advocacy areas of the Alliance are not included in the dues assessment.
